



Quickly and easily infuse blood or fluid bolus

- Set up <2 minutes

- Stabilize the patient



REASSESS

Assess patient response to infusion

- Monitor perfusion
- Evaluate changes in vital signs and level of consciousness



REDUCE


Reduce interventions & time to disposition

- Make diagnosis and treatment decisions faster
- Reduce mechanical ventilation⁵

Minutes Matter in the Golden Hour


In patients with severe hemorrhage, every minute of delay in resuscitation increases mortality.^{1,2}
